WHAT TO SEE

High Island formation is most famous for its spectacular columnar jointed volcanic rock formed about 140 million years ago as a result of catastrophic volcanic eruption. The size and extent of those columnar joints exposed at High Island Reservoir can be rarely seen in other places of the world. During the technical visit, Prof. Gang Wang from HKUST will introduce history of volcanic activities in Hong Kong, formation of columnar joints, mineral composition in the rock, and other geological features around the site.
