Highlights:

The project comprises of 3 new education facilities buildings for an International School, the Independent Schools Foundation (ISF) Academy at Pok Fu Lam. The extension will involve the construction of 3 new buildings and associated A&A works including 5 new linkbridges between new and existing blocks, new water tanks and new MOE staircase. The construction shall have minimal impact to the existing operating school campus.

The new buildings are predominantly of RC construction, block 3B1 is 7 storeys high and comprises of exhibition area, 900 seat double deck performance hall, 25m standard swimming pool, outdoor playground and other facilities. Block 3B2 is 12 storeys high and comprises of a two storey deep, 35m span transfer truss of composite construction, transferring 10 storeys of classrooms and offices over an existing EVA and car ramp.
