Project Background:

The Project is to expand the sewage treatment capacity and to upgrade the treatment level of the Pillar Point Sewage Treatment Works (PPSTW) in order to cater for the projected ultimate population and planned developments in the Tuen Mun area. Key elements of the Project includes upgrading of the sewage treatment level from preliminary treatment to chemically enhanced primary treatment with disinfection, expansion of the treatment capacity from 215 000 cubic metre per day to 241 000 cubic metre per day, provision of new septic waste reception and treatment facilities, and ancillary works.
