Programme Highlights

The ever growing awareness of the need to act in a sustainable manner is prompting innovation in recycling practices. This seminar will present two case studies of sustainable practices in the State of Victoria, Australia.

- (i) A review of operation methods of the City of Greater Geelong which is a regional Council. In particular, cost comparisons of stabilization versus resheeting of gravel roads, as well as conventional road construction and maintenance of rural and urban roads. In addition, social benefits are also highlighted.
- (ii) Outlining of the benefits of recycled usage in foam bitumen stabilisation, and also quantification of carbon emission savings in a Victorian bayside council.

Speaker: Mr Brian O'DONNELL

Brian O'Donnell has worked in the Australian local government sector for 45 years and for 19 years he was in charge of Municipal Engineering Offices. He is a former Chair of the National Engineers Australia Civil College Board and he is a former President of the Institute of Public Works Engineers Australia (IPWEA).
